

# Local SF Girl Still Missing

**P**olice are trying to locate Evalyn Katherine Lucien, a 17 year old girl who went missing last Sunday. She was last seen by her friend Beth Foley, at Coit Tower where the two had recently been spending time with a group of young people. Evalyn, also known as Eva, is approximately five feet and seven inches tall. She was last seen wearing a black skirt and a well

worn denim jacket, and had recently cut her hair short.

Ms. Lucien achieved local notoriety last year as a result of a series of elaborate pranks that she enacted on the students and faculty of Galilileo High School. One such prank resulted in her expulsion, as well as the investigation of Principal Moore as a suspect in an embezzlement scheme (no criminal charges have been filed). According to San Francisco Police, Ms. Lucien had a "not insubstan-

tial" criminal record including both citations and arrests for disorderly conduct, truancy, and underage drinking. While these signs may point to a

runaway, police say, they have not ruled out other causes for her disappearance.

Blair Lucien, Evalyn's father, told investigators that his daughter had started seeing a professional psychologist. In addition to the official police investigation, there are indications that a private investigator has also been retained by Evalyn's father. The Chronicle could not reach Mr. Lucien for comment directly. Any information about her disappearance should be directed to the missing persons unit at the San Francisco Police Department.
